## **Summer & Full-Time Accounting Recruitment**

Recruiting an Edwards Student is a simple process, and our office provides support and all of our services at the Edwards School of Business for **free of charge**:

- 1. Post your job on <u>Careerlink.usask.ca</u> you can do this, or our office can post for you
- 2. The interested students will apply to your job posting or you can direct them to your website
- 3. You will receive a resume book after your job deadlines, if they apply on CareerLink
- 4. You decide if you want to interview any of the students no obligation to hire a student
- 5. Our office will contact the students and create your interview schedule (no playing phone tag)
- 6. We have a restricted offer period (September 3<sup>rd</sup> to October 24<sup>th</sup>) and offers get presented to full-time/summer student(s) on October 24<sup>th</sup> at 9:00am students will have until Monday October 28<sup>th</sup> to accept or decline.

#### Information Sessions

Information sessions (for Co-op, Summer & FT Accounting recruitment) can be held:

- Between Sept. 11<sup>th</sup> October 18<sup>th</sup>
- As per student feedback we will only be booking one information session per night (your business will be the only information session booked at that day)

**Note:** If you would like to host a *2nd round* of sessions (ie. pre-interview social), please contact us to schedule as these will also be held one per night.

- Information sessions can happen anytime between 4:30 9:00 pm Monday to Thursday; and 2:30 4:30pm on Fridays
- Dates are reserved on a first come first served basis
- Information sessions can be held in person or virtual (on-campus or off-campus)
- RSVPs can be collected at no cost through Edwards Career Services
